The slant front desk from the Estate of Joan Glover McManus is a piece that was handed down from the estate of General John Glover. General John Glover served in the American Revolution and procured the watercrafts used for General George Washington crossing the Delaware River.

General John Glover was a Marblehead fisherman prior to the Revolution. His home is now a historic landmark.

The desk was passed down through his daughter, Hannah Johnson, and eventually to Grace L. Conway Schultz, then to the Estate of Joan Glover McManus.

Mrs. McManus' lineage to General John Glover was verified by the Daughters of the American Revolution for Mrs. McManus' entry into that organization.
