

SGT CHARLES D. LILLEY, BORN TOWN, NH WAS PART  
OF THE 52 ARMORED INFANTRY BRIGADE, 9TH ARMORED  
DIVISION WWII.

HE WAS CAPTURED IN THE BATTLE OF THE BULGE.  
HE DEVELOPED PNEUMONIA IN GERMAN P.O.W. CAMP,  
AND ONLY SURVIVED BECAUSE GERMAN DR. SCHMIDT  
DRAINED THE FLUID FROM HIS LUNGS. THEY  
CORRESPONDED AFTER THE WAR.

SGT LILLEY WAS EXTREMELY LOYAL TO HIS ARMY  
BUDDIES AND HELPED SET UP REUNIONS AT HIS  
HOME IN WEYMOUTH, MA, <sup>AS WELL AS</sup> SEATTLE, CAPE COD,  
NEW MEXICO AND NEW ORLEANS TO NAME A  
FEW.
